The purpose of the course

The topics of negative discrimination and equal treatment and opportunities have become the center of attention in the European Union and Hungary in the past decade. The purpose of the course is to acquaint the students, in addition to the legal background pertaining to equal opportunities also with the causes and consequences of the prevailing Hungarian situation. Special emphasis is paid to the issue of gender inequalities, as well as to those living with disabilities (focusing primarily on the vision and hearing impaired and the physically disabled). The condition of the third major group affected by discrimination i.e. the Roma, is covered by another course. The current course aims to examine the causes for stigmatizing women, those living with disabilities, and the Roma, as well as it delineates the advocacy networks striving to stamp out discrimination.
